

This is an example of a text-searchable PDF. Notice, in your PDF reader, what happens when you attempt to highlight a selection of text. You should be able to copy text from this document as you would a standard text document, or web page. Most PDF readers have the ability to link together different kinds of text contained in a single file, regardless of the font, style or positioning of the text.¹

Vertical text, such as this, should still be recognized by your PDF reader.
